

ACADEMIC FLAGS IN STARFISH



Instructors are encouraged to raise Starfish Flags for students in their courses. The flag an instructor raises will best describe your individual situation and alert the people in your Success Network (e.g. your major advisor, support staff) on how to best guide you to academic success.

Pro Tip: Be sure to read the comments from your instructors for guidance on next steps.



ACADEMIC FLAG: CLASS ATTENDANCE CONCERN

If you have not been attending class regularly, have been tardy frequently, and/or are not meeting expectations for the classes attendance policy .

ACADEMIC FLAG: LOW AVERAGE IN COURSE

If you have multiple low scores on tests, quizzes, and assignments, and/or your class average is below a C.



ACADEMIC FLAG: AT-RISK OF FAILING

If your course grade or overall performance is putting you in danger of failing the course.

ACADEMIC FLAG: MISSING/LATE ASSIGNMENTS

If you are missing and/or have late assignments that can jeopardize your success in the course.
