

Minerva's Academic Curriculum (MAC)

MAC is UNCG's new general education curriculum starting in Fall 2021. Through MAC, undergraduate students will engage in learning experiences and develop skills in 11 competencies by taking one 3 semester hour course in each competency below, totaling 33-34 semester hours.
